- » Follow a tailored scope of work designed by Rebuilding Together with materials and tools provided on site

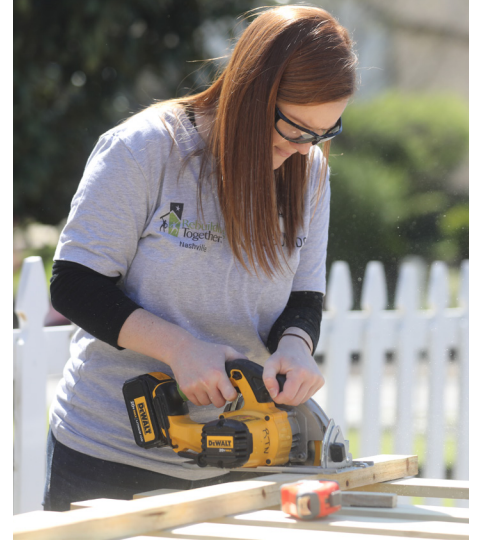
What will Rebuilding Together provide?

- » A project home and workscope that fits the skill-level of your group
- » Project coordination leading up to the ReBuild day
- » Day-of leadership to provide instruction and lead volunteers on site

What is your investment?

We ask for a minimum of a \$5,000 donation for a weekday build and \$10,000 donation for a weekend build to support the project and our work leading up to a typical [Re]Build day, which consists of 10-12 volunteers at one home. Larger groups require a multi-site project and more coordination, so we ask that donations scale with the number of volunteers. Total donation amount may vary depending on the specific project and volunteers.
