

# **Rebuilding Together's Community Advisory Committee (CAC)**

**Purpose:** Rebuilding Together's Community Advisory Committee (CAC) will advise Rebuilding Together on its home repair and community revitalization work, specifically in the Greater Bordeaux community.

## What are the responsibilities of the CAC?

- -Attending bi-monthly CAC meetings
- -Reviewing and selecting community projects
- -Serving as community liaisons to our Board of Directors
- -Assisting and attending outreach events
- -Helping with hospitality at volunteer days
- -Making introductions between Rebuilding Together and their networks
- -Supporting Rebuilding Together staff as needed
- -Agreeing to be listed on print and web materials as members of the CAC

### Who will serve on the CAC?

5-10 individuals, a majority of whom will reside in the Greater Bordeaux boundaries. Membership will not be limited to homeowners, but previous recipients of Rebuilding Together's services are encouraged to apply.

#### How will members be selected?

- -Members of the community will self-nominate or nominate someone via a 1-page application (*coming soon*)
- -Proposed members of the CAC will be recommended by Rebuilding Together's staff and approved by the Rebuilding Together Program committee

## What support and benefits would a CAC member receive?

-Stipend to cover costs of travel to meetings and time; an opportunity to use your time and talents to better your community!
